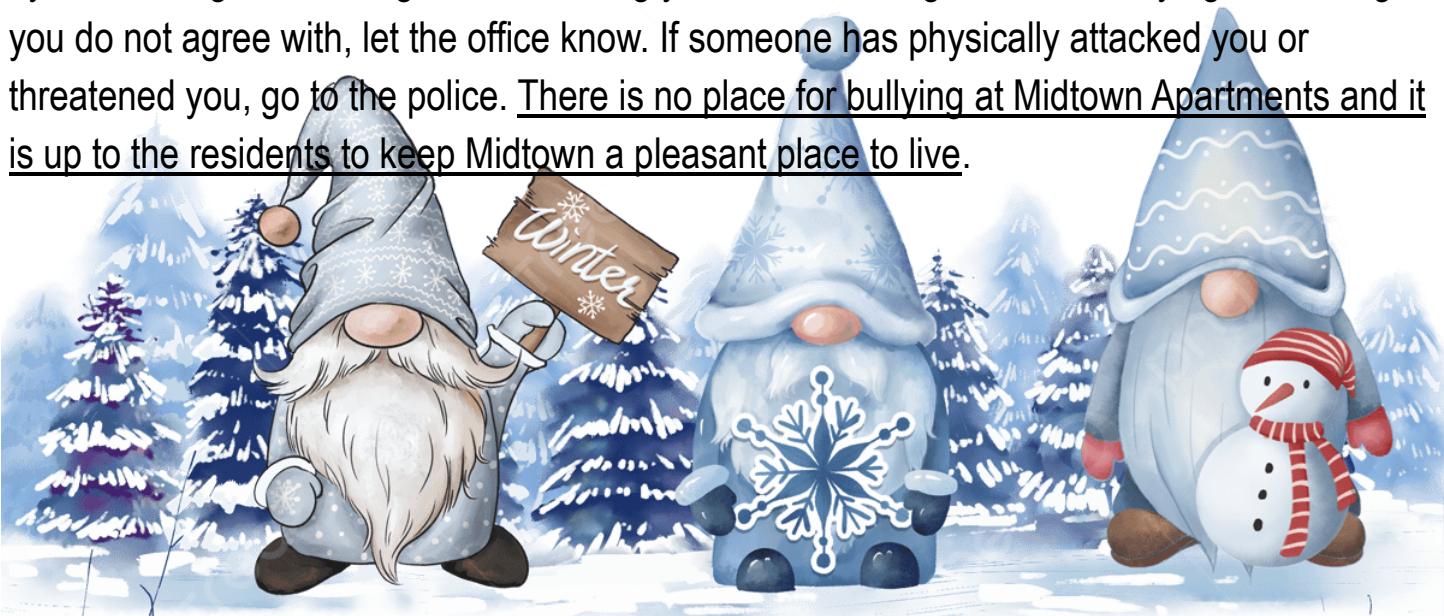

There are many factors that are necessary for thunder and snow to coexist. The first is that warm air needs to push upward against colder air in the clouds, creating a shift in the temperatures. When the warm air rises from the ground, it forms a turbulent storm cloud and creates the storm. But did you know: it's harder to see lightning in the winter and the snow can sometimes dampen the sound of thunder!



Maintenance will continue to keep the sidewalks and parking lots clear of snow and ice but remember, **you must move your car in order for the spot to be plowed.** Move your car to an already plowed spot, and leave room away from the curb, so maintenance is able to clear out the entire parking lot.
